Effective January 1, 2012, the Colorado Supreme Court adopted Pilot Rules for business litigation filed in certain Judicial District Courts, including the First Judicial District. The Pilot Rules apply to all business litigation, including contract disputes, real property litigation, UCC litigation, insurance coverage disputes, and business dissolutions. The Pilot Rules implement significant changes to the disclosure rules, discovery, and judicial case management.

Judge Munsinger and Ms. Taylor will explain how and why the Pilot Rules were adopted, and how they are being implemented in the First Judicial District. This will include what you need to know before you file a business litigation complaint, and what to expect from the courts as the case progresses.
